BACK TO BUSINESS

Clean and safe

At the end of the lockdown, objects everywhere are being put back into operation. An operator needs answers to the questions: What should be done now? Is a general cleaning enough or do all surfaces have to be disinfected?

The following steps should be carried out to ensure that users have perfectly hygienic surroundings:



IMPORTANT STEPS BEFORE RESTARTING

Identify the contact points for every site.

SURFACES

1 Unused > 14 days before opening:
Trouble-free cleaning with conventional maintenance cleaning products such as alcohol-based or all-purpose cleaners.

2 Frequent hand or skin contact after opening:
Prophylactic disinfecting treatment. Several times a day, depending on frequency of contact.

KITCHEN

Wash dishes and cutlery in the dishwasher at 60° C with a detergent for dishwashers.

As a general rule, do not wash dishes and cutlery by hand.

LAUNDRY

Normal laundry:
Bleach-containing products > all detergents offered as powders.
Wash cycle at minimum 60° C.

Laundry likely to be infected or confirmed as infectious:
Hygiene requirements for laundry issued by VAH or RKI.

Set up a new routing system to limit points of contact and air out the rooms several times during the day. Ensure strict compliance with all hygiene rules.

Do not forget hand disinfection!



Put disinfectant (3 ml) on your hands and rub until they feel dry (at least 30 seconds).



Be sure to disinfect fingertips and under the nails.



NEVER put disinfectant **ON WET HANDS!**





Industry Recommendations

- ✓ Wash hands.
- ✓ Observe etiquette for coughing and sneezing.
- ✓ Stay at home with any symptoms of illness.
- ✓ Do not share cups, glasses or items such as keyboards.
- ✓ Eat meals alone if possible.
- ✓ Do not hold any unnecessary meetings or get-togethers.
- ✓ Maintain distance to others.
- ✓ Wear a mask or face covering that covers nose and mouth.
- ✓ Regularly air out rooms.
- ✓ Good cleaning: clean surfaces where contact is made with hands and skin, several times per day if contact is very frequent.
- ✓ Disinfect surfaces as needed.
- ✓ Avoid using public transportation on the way to work; for example, commute by bicycle

BACK TO BUSINESS

Restarting after COVID-19



Special emphasis is placed on the cleaning of surfaces in exterior or public areas. Whether disinfecting certain surfaces outside healthcare facilities is required at all should be decided on a case-by-case basis, depending on the actual contamination of the surfaces. Routine surface disinfection in homes or public areas and of surfaces with frequent contact is not recommended even during the current COVID pandemic. In these cases, proper and appropriate cleaning is the method of choice.*
